MEDIA ADVISORY

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Government of the Republic of Indonesia will host the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits in Jakarta from 2-7 September 2023. Meetings will be held at the following venues:

B. MEDIA REGISTRATION

1. All media are required to register at <https://asean2023.id/> in Media Registration menu or at <https://media-registration.asean2023.id/>. One email can only be used to register one time only. Onsite registration will not be available.
2. Those registered at the previous 42nd ASEAN Summit media registration website can directly click the sign-up button, enter the same email, click get access, and then check the email for the password and information to log in.
3. For those who have never registered at the previous 42nd ASEAN Summit media registration website, please click the sign-up button, enter the details to the sign-up form, click submit, and then check the email to get the password and information to log in.
4. In-person attendance and direct coverage from Indonesia will be enabled through these mechanisms:

A. Official Media

A list of Media Officer (MO), Official Media (OM), and Official Traveling Press (OTP) needs to be sent via the diplomatic channel as well as must be registered by the MO. Delegates can only submit 1 (one) Note Verbale to register MO, OM, and OTP. Changes afterward will not be facilitated.

- Media Officer (MO)
Each Delegate shall appoint one MO to work with the Committee. MO will take responsibility for their OM and OTP and will act as a contact point for any information needed before and/or during the event.
- Official Media (OM)
OM are official photographers and/or videographers of the Head of State/Government, Secretary General of the United Nations, Secretary General of ASEAN, or Head of Intergovernmental/International Organizations.
- Official Traveling Press (OTP)
OTP are journalists, part of the delegates traveling with the Head of State/Government, Secretary General of the United Nations, Secretary General of ASEAN, or Head of Intergovernmental/International Organizations when attending the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits.

B. Invited Press

Invited press are foreign and national journalists accredited and holders of the official invitation letter of the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits issued by the Organizing Committee.

5. Documents/data needed:

- a. Self-photo with white background, suggested in JPEG, JPG or PNG format (max 1 MB)
- b. Scanned ID (KTP/Passport/KITAS), suggested in JPEG, JPG or PNG format (max 1 MB)
- c. Scanned media ID, suggested in JPEG, JPG or PNG format, (max 1 MB)
- d. Assignment letter from media institution, suggested in PDF format (max 200 kb)
- e. Name of Media Company
- f. Location of Media Company
- g. Journalist position (camper/reporter/photographer)

Additional documents needed for foreign journalist from abroad:

- h. Scanned return ticket, suggested in JPEG or PDF format (max 1 MB)
- i. Hotel / accommodation booking in Indonesia for foreign journalists, suggested in JPEG or PDF format (max 1 MB).
- j. List of equipment in PDF format (max 1 MB).

6. Online registration is open from **5 to 25 August 2023**. Accreditation will be granted to all those who register on the specified date.
7. A verification email will be sent immediately to the registered email address after your registration form was successfully approved. If you experience any technical issues

while registering, please contact media.registration@asean2023.id with email subject: 43rd ASEAN Summit Media Registration - *Media Name*.

8. Please be informed that incomplete registration will not be processed.

C. VISA APPLICATION

9. Journalists who have received an official invitation to cover the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits are required to apply for a journalist visa. Visa on Arrival may be granted for specific conditions.
10. The aforementioned exemption entails granting limited short-term visit for special purposes towards accredited journalists. In order to obtain a Journalist Notification Letter, kindly contact the nearest Indonesian Missions in your respective country and submit required documents as follows:
 - a. Passport with the validity of at least 6 (six) months beyond the date of entry in Indonesian territory.
 - b. Official assignment letter from the media institutions.
 - c. Copy of media ID.
 - d. Proof of return ticket.
 - e. Official invitation Letter of AMM/PMC from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia.
 - f. List of equipment (description, weight, value, country of origin).

D. HEALTH PRECAUTIONS

11. To guarantee the health and safety of all participants, it is advisable to wear masks and implement hygienic measures at all times.

E. CUSTOMS CLEARANCE REQUIREMENT

12. Media representatives are encouraged to have CBP/ATA Carnets in order to expedite the customs clearance process.
13. All equipment should be shipped out of Indonesia by the end of the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits.

F. ID BADGE

14. Media badges can be collected at Best Western Senayan Hotel, Emerald Room (6th floor), on **1 – 5 September 2023 from 10.00 to 17.00 (GMT+7)**.
15. Journalists or their representative must show their Official Invitation and photo ID when collecting media badges.

16. Media badges must be worn at all times within the designated event access-controlled areas while covering the events. Media badges are strictly non-transferable and will not be replaced if missing or damaged.

G. ACCOMODATION AND TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

17. **All journalists are responsible for their own travel arrangements, hotel reservations, and payments.** Journalists are strongly encouraged to make reservations at the earliest possible time.

19. During the events, complimentary vehicles will be available for transferring photographers and videographers from the Media Center to designated venues and vice versa.

H. ACCESS TO EVENTS

20. Most official events are restricted to a certain number of media representatives and will be arranged through a media pool. Media will be at all times screened before entering the meeting venues and escorted, while they are at the meeting venues.

I. MEDIA CENTER

21. Media Centre is set up as the primary venue for journalist working stations, press releases distribution, providing host broadcast clean feeds, media booth and press conference rooms during the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits.
22. The Media Center will operate at the Exhibition Hall B of Jakarta Convention Center (JCC) on:

2 – 4 September 2023: from 09.00 AM – 08.00 PM

5 – 8 September 2023: from 07.00 AM – 10.00 PM

*Western Indonesia Time (GMT+7)

It is important to note that the Media Center can only accommodate a maximum capacity of ±2.000 individuals. The utilization of the Media Center will be based on a first-come, first-served basis.

23. A press conference hall and interview rooms may be used free of charge after reservation. Reservations can be made at the Media Center Information Desk during operational hours. This service is provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
24. The Information Desk will be set up at the Media Center. Event schedule, vehicles transfer schedule, room bookings, and other media programs/queries will also be available in this area.
25. Workstations will be provided with working desks, charging stations, internet, computers, and a printing area for all accredited journalists to use during the events.
26. The Media Center will provide a limited number of agency booths. Each booth is equipped with tables and chairs, and power sockets. The use of this facility should be reserved in advance. Reservation is made on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations can be made to **Mr. Sujud (M: +62 812 8560 3903)**.
27. During 43rd ASEAN Summit and Related Summits, the Media Center will provide broadcast service, including Host Broadcast feeds, payable satellite transmission services, clean feed footage uplinks, raw and programmed footage, cut to cut on demand footage, broadcasting assistance, and custom configuration press-conference rooms for hire.
